Due to COVID protocols and guidelines we were unable to allow parents in the building as much as we would like. With the anticipation of restrictions being lifted in the fall we will once again require each family in the 2021-2022 school year to earn Volunteer Hours.

Active parents enhance the school's ability to provide an excellent education in a Christ-centered environment. When a parent takes the time to come to school, the message is sent to his/her child that school is a priority in our family. It is with this in mind that the school, in coordination with the Home and School Association and our School Advisory Council, has developed a **MANDATORY VOLUNTEER** program. Each family will be required to VOLUNTEER at least **20 hours** during the 2021-2022 school year. For every hour not met, that family will have a \$15 fee charged to FACTS.




Summer Enrichment Program June 7-17 Monday-Thursday

St. Mary's Academy

Mr. Hal Plummer, superintendent of Catholic schools for the Archdiocese of Atlanta, announced today that the new Catholic school on the southside of Atlanta will be called St. Mary's Academy.



The new preK-12 school, a consolidation of Our Lady of Victory Catholic School in Tyrone and Our Lady of Mercy Catholic High School (OLM) Fayetteville, is scheduled to open in the fall of 2022 on the OLM campus. Archbishop Gregory Hartmayer, OFM Conv., has approved the name.

"It's going to be called St. Mary's Academy because the two schools we are bringing together are named after the Blessed Virgin Mary, so it seemed appropriate to continue to place the schools under her maternal care," explained Plummer.
